

The Reformer Martin Luther is credited with saying, *“If you preach the Gospel in all its aspects with the exception of the issues that deal specifically with your time, you are not preaching the Gospel at all.”* My article for this month is what you might call a “poetic” attempt at preaching the Gospel to a world that needs it right now! Amen ...

To know the living Christ is to know the Jesus who is **Lamb of God** – the lamb who has allowed the world to trample Him under its feet so that His precious blood would be spilt for their sins. For us white, tread the winepress of God’s wrath against those who use racial tension to demonize the non-racist and who call anarchy justice!

Our hope can only come from YOUR absolutely free wielding of true righteousness as you honestly and thoroughly call our world to account!

Come, LORD JESUS, Come! Only then will there *“no longer ... be any curse.”* Only then will *“The throne of God and of the Lamb ... be in the city.”* Only then will *“They ... see his face, and His name ... be on their foreheads.”* Only then will *“There ... be no more night.”* Only then will we *“... not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord God will give [us] light.”* Only then will you *“... reign for ever and ever.”* (Revelation 22:3-5)
